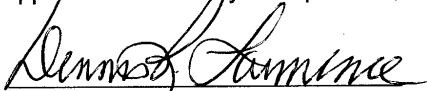


**AMENDMENT TO THE DECLARATION FOR CONDOMINIUM OF
NORTHRIDGE PATIO HOMES CONDOMINIUMS**

The general intents of this amendment are to restrict the size and number of dogs that may be kept as household pets in any Unit of the Northridge Patio Homes Condominiums and to ensure that such animals will reside primarily indoors. It also provides that those dogs currently belonging to Unit Owners will be "grandfathered" into acceptance by the Northridge Patio Homes Condominium Association but must nevertheless be confined at all times within the limited common area of the Unit Owner. Any dog allowed outdoors temporarily into a common area must be restrained by leash. Accordingly, the following specific amendment to the DECLARATION FOR CONDOMINIUM OF NORTHRIDGE PATIO HOMES CONDOMINIUMS is hereby approved and adopted:

1. Paragraph 8.f of the Declaration shall be amended to provide that "No animals of any kind shall be raised, bred, or kept in any Unit, except that small dogs, cats, and other household pets may be kept as subject to rules and regulations from time to time adopted or amended by the Association. Such rules shall state that no more than two dogs weighing less than 36 pounds each may reside within a Unit. No dog shall be permitted to roam freely but whenever outdoors must be restrained by leash at all times or else confined within the Unit Owner's fenced limited common area for a temporary period only. Those dogs already belonging to a Unit Owner as of October 4, 2003, are exempted from the above rule of size, but must nevertheless be confined within their owner's limited common area whenever outdoors. All solid waste must be immediately disposed of from Association lands or general common areas. No additional structures shall be set up on any Association land or general common area for the benefit of such pets. At no time shall any dog or other pet become a nuisance or source of annoyance to other Unit Owners. In that event, the complaint can be brought up to the Association for vote as to how to best handle the pet."

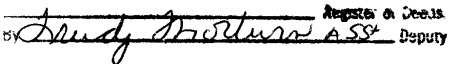

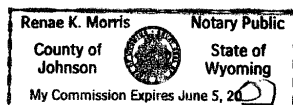

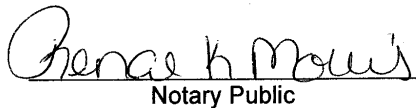
